# What was decided:


To ask Mr. Kuzma who can sit on the Nominating Committee and who approves them.

# What has happened since our last meeting?

• Jola, her husband and several other of PAC-Michigan members are ready to travel to Trump's inauguration. They will go there on Saturday and return on Wednesday. We would love to hear about her adventure.

# We talked about:

- Due to the large amount of time spent on discussing Trump's inauguration and the subsequent failure of my laptop, the report from the last meeting was not read.
- A trip to Trump's inauguration was discussed. We had fun bringing up expected situations. Jola described how to check hotel beds for bedbugs. Andrzej checked the weather: bitter cold is expected from 31 during a day to 8 at night degrees F on Monday (inauguration day).

# What has happened since our last meeting?

- Jola, Tomek and Jacek went to D.C for Trump's inauguration.
- Ryszard, Jurek and Janusz told us about Mr. Kuzma's meeting on Tuesday. PAC's letter from Trump on continued support for Ukraine was discussed.
- TV Republica organized a Ball and Conference in DC.

### We talked about:

- 2 reports from 2 weeks were read and commented on.
- Trump's inauguration in D.C. Jola, Tomek and Jacek described the events in which they participated. Several people came from Poland. Among them were former PM Mateusz Morawiecki, and former Minister of Education Przemysław Czarnek.
- Candidates for the EC. Jola suggested Stella. She might be good for Treasurer. Jurek from Florida will run for VP for Polish Affairs. There are two candidates for president: Mark Pienkos and Tomek Niemyjski. Andrzej from New Jersey should be ready to run for VP for American Affairs.
- Pulaski bookmark. Krzysiek argued that is necessary to mention the Polish legions in Haiti and Kosciuszko.
- Halina's idea to establish the Polish-American National Foundation. Jola suggested that to be on the board; one must have Polish roots and in case of termination of activity, The money should go to Polish organizations. Everyone agreed that we should start by forming an organizing committee.

- Jola will contact Stella and try to convince her to run for a position in the EC.
- Krzysiek will prepare his proposal to include info about the Polish legions in Haiti and Kosciuszko in Pulaski bookmark.
- Zbyszek will invite Andrzej Tomek Niemyjski to join us on Thursday at 3 pm or week later on Wednesday at 8 pm regarding his candidacy for the president of the EC.

https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Barbara Nowacka Her Partner: Adrian Zandberg, Maciej As Minister of National Education, Barbara Nowacka has introduced many changes in Polish schools. The <u>cursed soldiers</u>, historical personalities such as <u>Witold Pilecki</u>, <u>Maximilian Kolbe</u> and events such as the <u>Greater Poland Uprising</u> have been removed from the curriculum. Also, any mentions of the <u>Wola massacre</u> and the <u>Volhynia massacre</u> have also been removed. Subjects such as human rights, the EU and the UN have instead received more space in the new curriculum.

Nowacka justified the changes as follows: "History shouldn't serve anyone's interests. Neither political, nor ideological. It can't be an instrument of creating separations or excluding some groups."

On the 27th of January 2025 Nowacka held a speech at the 80th anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz Death Camp. While reading from a script, she said that "under German occupation, Polish Nazis built concentration camps." Nowacka and PM Tusk claim it was a "slip of the tongue."

# What has happened since our last meeting?

- Jola convinced Stella from PAC-Michigan to run for EC Treasurer.
- The 80th Anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz was commemorated in Poland.
- German's newspapers were quick to quote Minister Nowacka's remarks about Polish Nazis.
- PAC President Frank Spula responded to Minister Nowacka's speech on behalf of PAC and Polonia. President of CPA Leszek Pawlik did the same. His statement was signed by several PAC divisions and Polish American organizations.
- Zbyszek invited officers of the PAC Executive Committee to join a PACT meeting: VP for Financial Development, Tomek Niemyjski and First VP, Dr. Mark Pienkos.
- PAC-LI held a meeting at the Polish American Museum in Port Washington on Sunday at 2 pm.
  Ryszard welcomed the participants, Halina introduced the distinguished guests, Zbyszek
  presented the projects and answered questions. Then a group of children sang Christmas carols
  and 3 members of the Oginski choir also sang. There was more singing at the reception that
  followed. More than 20 people showed up and three of them joined PAC-LI.

# We talked about:

- report from the last week was read and commented on.
- Leszek's proposal to organize a Conference inspired by Minister Nowacka's mistake. Dr. Andrzej rightly suggested that the Conference should be called "Falsifying History". He mentioned the late Gordon Black, a university professor of philosophy and ethics. Gordon was convinced that people's beliefs could be changed. One of his achievements was to get Gross to publicly admit that we do not really know the facts about Jedwabne until the exhumation. Presidential candidates plus Ms. Nowacka should be invited to the conference.
- PAC bookmark. Dr. Mark agreed that it would be beneficial to prepare such a publication.
- Tim's presidential informal monthly meetings on Polish and American affairs.
- PAC Elections in the fall. Dr. Mark: we should press EC to announce in advance who is running.
- What is necessary for the PAC to be effective and attractive. There are organizations that do not know about PAC and are very active. We should reach out to them and invite them to cooperate with us. Importance of communication and social media. We should have committees working on specific projects in coordination with the EC.
- Poland Caucus has only 14 members compared to 100 members for other ethnic groups.
- What needs to be done to bring new, energetic people to the EC.

- Jola will propose to Mr. Spula to organize PAC Convention in Michigan this year.
- Zbyszek will start working on a PAC bookmark and will consult with the PACT group.
- Dr. Mark suggested asking Mr. Kuzma to put on the agenda what we would like to discuss, and Irena suggested asking for short minutes (there were no minutes so far).
- Halina would like to see a film made about the achievements of PAC on its 80th anniversary just as it was made on its 70th anniversary.

Our efforts failed; Donald Trump nominated Thomas Rose as Ambassador to Poland. According to Indianapolis Monthly he is a "staunch conservative, a fervent Zionist, and an Orthodox Jew."

We did not have the IOM meeting In January because the first Wednesday fell on New Year's Day

# What has happened since our last meeting?

- ~50% of 2024 email recipients responded to Zbyszek's request if they want to receive PACT/IOM emails in 2025: 9 PAC division presidents, 1 National VP, 6 other organization presidents, and 9 others wish to continue receiving information about weekly meetings.
- Zbyszek invited Andrzej Tomek Niemyjski, VP for Financial Development, to the PACT meeting.
- Jurek took part in the Blanka Rosenstiel's annual Polonaise Ball. Present during the brunch were, among others, Prof. Marek Chodakiewicz, Dr. Jim Mazurkiewicz and Mr. Bogdan Klich, head of mission at the Embassy of the Republic of Poland (not yet approved by President Duda as ambassador). The 60 Million Congress this time did not take place on the same days; it will take place in March. The chairman Zbigniew Klonowski, was not present at the Polonaise.

### We talked about:

- Report from the last week was read and commented on.
- PAC bookmark. Irena suggested grammatical corrections: use capital letters after colon and improve the description of why the delegates of organizations gathered in Bufalo in 1944.
- Action in Washington: visit to the offices of 535 legislators with the brochure about Poland plus Pulaski and Kosciuszko bookmarks. Two reasons why we are going: 1. To inform about Poland, 2. We would like legislators to consult us when decisions are made concerning Poland or Polonia.
- Potentially valuable candidates for EC positions. It was a long and informative exchange of views between the participants. The work of the current VPs was evaluated. Mr. Spula's candidates for President were assessed: Chmielewski and Cieromski.
- Committees/ teams to work with VPs on selected projects.
- Improving communication between the EC and divisions. Why the virtual office idea was rejected. Currently the tel. to PAC: 773 286-5047 is redirected to Mrs. Bozena Kaminski.
- An initiative by Tomek from Arizona aimed at encouraging and helping Polish students in finding jobs in legislative offices. There are currently 47 students in the PAC division.
- Tomek from Arizona raised twenty leaders. This is what he is most proud of.
- What does Poland expect from Polonia? Return to their homeland and help Polish businesses.
- National organizations and divisions belonging to the PAC. How many NDs can a division have.
- A task for the VP for Membership Development to establish PAC divisions in new states.

### What was decided:

- We need to find good candidates willing to run for the positions of Vice President for Membership and Education in the EC.
- Zbyszek will implement the participants' suggestions in the PAC bookmark. Including Dr. Mark Pienkos as the contact person.
- Jola will try to convince her Congressman, John James, to join the Poland Caucus.

# What has happened since our last meeting?

- On Sunday, Halina and Zbyszek attended Piotr Rubik's concert at St. Kostka Church in Greenpoint as part of his North America tour.
- 85-th Anniversary of the first deportation to Siberia at the Polish Consulate in New York. Helena Knapczyk, 98, shared her experiences. According to Halina, about 100 people participated in it.
- Mr. Kuzma's meeting will take place next week on Tuesday at 8 PM ET.
- Jonathan Silverstein, former President of Polish Student Club at the University of Texas works in the congressional office. Tomek from Ohio found out about it.
- Zbyszek left messages for three PAC division Presidents: Jim Lawicki Northwest NY, Tom Mroczek - Central NY, Wiesiek Wierzbowski - East Massachusetts and asked them to personally join the weekly meetings or delegate someone. He also called Tomek Niemyjski to get a list of National organizations and to continue the conversation about the elections. Nobody replied.

### We talked about:

- Report from last week was read and commented on.
- PAC leaflet (originally called a bookmark). Zbyszek presented the conclusions from the meeting with Andrzej and Krzysiek: depending on the recipients, different versions must be prepared.
- Candidates for PAC President. Ryszard beliefs that Dr. Pienkos would have more time to get involved, Jola is convinced that Mr. Niemyjski has more energy, ideas and knows Polish.
   The remaining participants in the discussion took a pragmatic position recalling that experience and contribution to the PAC would certainly be taken into account by voters.
- Mrs. Kaminski has contacts with the Chamber of Commerce. Possibility to raise money for PAC.
- Accomplishments and plans of the VP for membership and VP for Financial Development.
- Opinions about the VP for PR and her opinion about those who support "Flavor of Poland".
- Who American politicians respect/fear. It was recalled that Jonathan Jay Pollard gave Israel topsecret classified information, including the U.S. intelligence gathering process, its sources and methods, sentenced to life in prison, was released by Trump in 2020 and decorated by Netanyahu. Since moving to Israel, Pollard has advocated the relocation of Gaza Arabs to Ireland.
- Why PiS lost the elections according to Zbyszek's patriotic and conservative friend.
- Political situation before presidential elections in Poland.

- Jola will raise 4 issues during Kuzma's meeting: a letter to the new Ambassador, the PAC Convention in Arizona or Michigan, names of candidates for the EC and the NDs list.
- Zbyszek will invite Stella Szczesny to our next meeting to talk about the upcoming PAC elections.
- Zbyszek reminded to look for volunteers willing to visit the offices of 535 legislators in DC in March or April. We need 4 teams of 3-5 people each.
- Jola will find a person to call to PAC: 773 286-5047 to check this No. effectiveness.
- Krzysiek wants us to focus mainly on the Action Points during our meetings. Zbyszek, as a reminder, will pull out "What was decided:' from the reports from recent months.
- Jola will ask John James, her congressman to support the exhumation in Wolyn.
- Jola: the new archbishop of Detroit must receive a letter from Polona regarding the seminary.
- It should be suggested to the CPA to send a letter to Thomas Rose with congratulations and wording about Polish nation expressed by newly nominated Ambassador.
- Zbyszek will work on contacts with divisions, Andrzej will try to establish contacts with National Organizations.

# What has happened since our last meeting?

- On Saturday, the father of Andrzej Tomek Niemyjski, a well-known a very active volunteer in the Arizona Polonia, died.
- On Tuesday Tim Kuzma held his monthly meeting for EC members and presidents of divisions and national organizations.
- Yesterday, Andrzej, Krzysiek and zk worked on improving the PAC bookmark for politicians.
- Jola sent a letter to Congressman John James, asking him to support the exhumation in Wolyn.
- Zbyszek talked to Mrs. Stella Szczesny and invited her to our meeting.

### We talked about:

- The report from last week was read and commented on.
- Winter conditions, snow and cold at participants' locations.
- Ravensbruck camp. Halina shared the project of an American woman.
- 5 plane tickets to Wroclaw. Tomek from Cleaveland, Ohio is planning a vacation with his family this Summer. Halina shared her experiences. Andrzej found tickets for \$1300 on Air Canada going to Poland and returning with Sweeden Airlines.
- 85<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the first deportation to Siberia in NY Consulate. Halina told us about it.
- Tim Kuzma's monthly meeting. Main topic was what message should be sent to American political leaders after VP President Vance's speech. According to Mirek Niedzinski, there are 10k American soldiers in Poland and Romania, compared with 35 k in Germany. The possibility of holding the PAC Convention in a location other than Chicago was discussed. Tim suggested reminding President Trump of his promise to invite the PAC to the White House. in addition to the 7 officers, 9 Presidents participated in the 1.5 h meeting. Next meeting is in 2 weeks, not in a month.
- PAC bookmarks. Zbyszek presented and read the version for politicians which was improved by Andrzej, Krzysiek and him. He also showed and read his preliminary draft for Polish Americans.
- Stella shared her ideas: to have a plan, news for members, better communication, VPs should be active not just hold titles. What might she do if elected to the VP for Cultural Affairs.
- Difficulties in communicating with some divisions. Zbyszek complained that after repeated phone calls and emails, he received no response from divisions in: Arizona, Boston, Buffalo and Central NY. We need to find ways to contact them because they can bring 12 ND to the PAC Convention.
- Visiting legislators' offices in D.C. Jacek found an inexpensive Econo Lodge Metro in Arlington:

In the beginning of this meeting, Tim Kuzma, PAC VP for American Affairs shared with us his idea of Advocacy Day on Capitol Hill which he plans to take place in May.

# What has happened since our last meeting?

- Ryszard sent an email to ND Forum about the Info Campaign in DC planned in April by PACT.
- Zbyszek sent an invitation to Mr. Rusk to our meeting. He received no response.
- Only Mr. Tim Kuzma responded to Ryszard's email regarding the action in DC. He wanted to meet on Zoom with Ryszard and Zbyszek. Ryszard talked to him.
- Zbyszek suggested to Tim that it would be best if he joined the PACT meeting in the evening.

### We talked about:

- Information Campaign on April 7-10 and Advocacy Day on May 6-7. Zbyszek presented his concept of preparing the ground before going to congressmen's offices with political demands. He argued that educating all (and not just selected few) legislators about Poland, Polonia and PAC gives us a better chance to get their attention. Tim did not see it as a necessity. His plan is to hold meetings with ~20 of the most prominent legislators, such committees' chairs. He needs 5 teams, each of 3-person including someone who speaks English well. Tim promised to have the lobbying proposal ready within 2 weeks. Everyone agreed that the biggest challenge would be finding enough people willing to go to DC.

- Vacation in Poland. Tomek is going with his wife and 3 children for 3 weeks in the Summer. He
  found plane tickets for just \$1050. They plan to visit family and friends and explore Zakopane,
  Krakow, Warszawa and Gdansk
- No contact with PAC divisions in Arizona, Boston, Buffalo, North New Jersey, Central NY. Zbyszek is worried because they could potentially bring more than 12 NDs to the PAC Convention.
- Ukrainian rally of 500 people in Cleaveland, Ohio. Tomek told us about this, about his speech and Marcy Kaptur's behavior.
- Constant presence in the minds of legislators. Jola and Krzysiek came up with a clever idea to
  periodically send info from the Polish Americans to all politicians. Who could and should do this a
  discussion ensued.
- Chat GPT. Tomek mentioned an Al program that can help with writing letters, speeches, etc.
- Promotion of Poland in social media. Instagram a social platform particularly popular among the younger generation recommended by Tomek.
- CNN production "Searching for Italy". Tomek is delighted with this series and recommended to watch. Promotion of Italy, something like "Flavor of Poland but on a commercial station (CNN).
