Finished projects:

- 1) The registration of two sections of PAC-LI; social (S) and political (P).
- 2) The By-Laws were written specifically for the PAC-LI and approved.
- 3) The Retirement Committee was formed and began their work.
- 4) Designed two kinds of information bookmarks about PAC-LI.
- 5) Two inter- divisional meetings were organized to exchange ideas and prepare suggestions for the PAC Executive Board,.
- 6) Created and published the PAC-LI website.

Present projects:

- 1) Elimination of the entry visa for Poles traveling to the USA (KPA-LI supports and cooperates with the PAC Head Quarters).
- 2) Initiating and helping to achieve the status of a sponsor by the PAC for the Polish and Slavic Federal Credit Union (P&S FCU).
- 3) Making a new Pulaski's plaque and relocating it to a more visible place (within the local square of the village of Floral Park, Long Island).
- 4) Cooperating and encouraging Polish Saturday Schools to prepare their students to face Anti-Polish propaganda.
- 5) Continuing inter- divisional meetings to exchange ideas and formulate proposals to be discussed during the PAC's bi- annual conferences.
- 6) Researching Polonia's interests in the form of questionnaire.
- 7) Organizing series of Panel discussions about future of Polonia.

Future projects:

- 1) Organizing the Library in the Polish National Club (PNC) in Hempstead.
- 2) Cooperating with all Polish organizations, schools and parishes on LI.
- 3) Elimination of American tax on Social Security benefits for non-citizens returning to Poland (25.5-% non-resident tax).
- 4) Elimination of Windfall Elimination Provision reduction of Social Security for retirees who also receive ZUS or KRUS (up to 50% of Polish benefits).
- 5) Establishing a Discussion Club.
- 6) Initiating the formation of first Polish Scouts on Long Island.
- 7) Relocation of the Katyn's plaque to more visible place (in the Eisenhower Park).
